## **America's Got Talent Finalists Sons of Serendip Deliver Soulful Pop At the Rialto on April 8**

**TACOMA, WASH.** – Serendipity brought a quartet of friends together at Boston University years ago to form a musical group that blends pop with vocals, guitar, piano, harp, and cello. The Sons of Serendip, who rose to fame on *America's Got Talent's* season nine, will be performing at Tacoma's historic Rialto Theater on Saturday April 8 at 7:30 p.m. [Tickets are now available, starting at \\$29.](#)

Sons of Serendip consists of members Micah Christian (vocals), Cordaro Rodriguez (piano and guitar), Kendall Ranseur (cello), and Mason Morton (harp). Rodriguez and Ranseur met as young boys living in the same neighborhood in Charlotte, North Carolina, and later attended Boston University together, where they reconnected and met their other bandmates. Together they have mastered a minimalist set, blending classical instruments with today's favorite hits. The Sons of Serendip transcend genres to deliver a soulful pop performance.

After only one prior performance in front of a live audience, the quartet appeared on the television series *America's Got Talent* in 2014 and quickly won over America with their renditions of "Somewhere Only We Know" and "Hallelujah." The Sons of Serendip were finalists on the show, and since have gone on to have a prosperous musical career. Their debut album topped the Billboard Top 100 Albums chart, and the group has received endless rave reviews.
