After a thorough review of 12 IT Service applicants, the Broadway Center for the Performing Arts (BCPA) is pleased to announce the IT Services RFP has been fulfilled and has awarded the contract for services to BrightWire Networks (BWN).

BWN has been serving the Olympia and South Puget Sound area since 2005, providing technical support, computer services, and consulting to small and medium-sized businesses. They provide enterprise-level IT practices and solutions to the small business sector. BWN's experience has allowed them to build and develop the infrastructure needed to keep prices affordable and clients up and running.

The BCPA is a private, non-profit arts organization with a 28 year history in downtown Tacoma. The BCPA manages the largest complex of theatres between Seattle and Portland on behalf of the City of Tacoma. These publically owned venues consist of the historic Pantages and Rialto Theaters and the contemporary Theatre on the Square. In addition, the Broadway Center manages the Jones Building, which is a 7 story office tower, and several mixed use spaces, which include three rehearsal studios and two classrooms. The BCPA is also a major arts presenter in the South Sound with a nearly year round season of events. The BCPA manages one of the largest arts education program in Washington State, which includes on site student matinees, touring performances in schools and a Conservatory offering on site and off site training in theatre, song and dance.
